
25. On Oak Street, 66.32 kilograms of trash was collected, and 31.21 kilograms of recyclables were collected in one week. How many kilograms were collected in all?




26. Sara found the sum of 35.6 and 42.8 shown below. Is her answer correct? If not, explain her mistake and write the correct answer.


- **27. Reason** Write a number that has a 7 in the tens place and a 9 in the hundredths place.
